Out of the twelve things planned above, we can successfully implement the first seven things but we could not fulfill completely the remaining five things planned.

We are happy to note that we could get improved the services rendered by Canara Bank to our employees and students. We are giving wide publicity to our activities through print and electronic media.

We are also happy to note that we could start M.Sc. (Biotechnology), M.Lib of Open University and M.Com. Course from this academic year.

**Part – B**

**1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution :**

The objectives of the college are framed so as to cultivate an atmosphere to enhance the accountability of students for their studies, teachers for their teaching and research and the institute as a whole to the quality of education keeping in mind the mission of the institution '**Pursuit of Excellence**', we follow certain principles. These are : selection of staff only and only on merit basis, ban on private tuitions by the teaching staff, commitment to rural sector, transparency in financial matters and in the conduct of examinations, motivation to all those involved in the educational system by conferring various awards.

**2. New academic Programmes initiated (UG and PG) :**

**3. Innovations in Curricular design and Transaction :**

Seminars are made compulsory for students at B.Sc. Third year (Microbiology / Physics / Chemistry / Mathematics / Computer Science and Biotechnology). Seminar is also compulsory at P.G. level in the Department of Geography. Industrial visit, field visit for on site learning projects and surveys are also undertaken by Science Department s.

Our teachers of Russian, Pali, Physics, Zoology and Fishery Science, Physics, Marathi, Chemistry are active in curriculum design of our as well as of other universities.

At the beginning of every year, teaching plan of the year is prepared by every teacher and progress of it is monitored regularly by the administration.

Two workshops in a semester and weekly seminars are arranged by the staff members of Computer Science and I.T. Department. All the teachers of IT meet informally during interval (10.15 to 10.30) every day.

Students of Biotechnology exhibited their projects at National Agricultural Exhibition held at Kavtha (Dist Osmanabad). The projects included vermiwash, integrated fish farm, neem products and bio-diesel. Our Biotechnology students and staff members participated in the National Level workshop organized by MIMSR Medical College, Latur and sponsored by Food and Nutrition Departments of Govt. Medical College and Maharashtra Chapter of Biochemistry.

Our Biotechnology students also participated in the National Workshop on Bio-fertilisers and Bio-pesticides at Dayanand College, Solapur.

Biotechnology students had first hand training at various institutes / industries.

Youth Festival and Educational Awareness week was organized during which various activities Rangoli, Debate, Essay, Poster Presentation, Competitions were held and guest lectures were arranged.

Camps were organized at Anandwan Sharm Snaskar Chhawani (5 male and / 5 female volunteers participated during 15 to 22 May 2005), Special Youth Camp at Renapur for Disaster Management in collaboration with local self Government during 18-10-2005 to 27-10-2005. In this camp 125 volunteers, 4 officers, 3 staff members took active part conducting village survey and taking active part in providing sanitary facilities.

Blood donation camp was also organized on 30-11-2005 in which 90 volunteers donated blood. Rare blood group students list is prepared.

Our library is computerized with bibliographic and membership data base by acquisition, circulation, cataloguing, serial control and OPEC modules for library operations.

Adequate computer and broadband internet facility with LAN through server and 21 terminals are provided.

**26. Increase in the infrastructural facilities :**

The Department of Microbiology has acquired additional laboratory equipment. We have provided inverter and power generator to the library and Ladies Hostel.

We have installed closed circuit TV Network with 24 cameras and three control units for supervision in the Library. Instruments and apparatus worth Rs. 12,70,172/- were purchased for the Department of Biotechnology. Additional four storeyed building construction is in progress.

Equipments worth Rs. 9,30,000/- were purchased for various units of the college.

**27. Technology upgradation :**

Earlier we had PSTN internet facility. From this year we have subscribed internet facility in the library. This is very useful for students, especially research students and teachers.

We have launched our college web site. Upgraded computers and softwares were purchased.

**28. Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students :**

We encourage staff and students to join MS-CIT course organized by Govt. of Maharashtra. This is a computer literacy programme subsidized by the Government for the propagation of training in computers and internet. Our college is a recognized centre of MKCL (Maharashtra Knowledge Corporation Limited) which runs these courses for the layman and special programmes for the teachers as well. Internet access facility is made available to students and teachers in the library.

**29. Financial aid to students :**

In addition to Govt. of India and State Government scholarships for various categories, we have instituted our own scholarship with the help of Philonthropists, Under this scheme, students are adopted and their expenses are taken care of. We have 'Earn and Learn' scheme for the economically backward students. Some of employees also adopt students and serve as their local guardians.

All the out-going students become primary members of the Alumni Association This association has promised us to contribute for the extension of poor boys' hostel building.

**31. Activities and support from the Parent-Teacher Association :**

Parents are invited for attending a common meeting at least once a year to discuss the relevant issues.

We have first aid kits kept in Chemistry, NCC, NSS, Microbiobgy, Botany, Zoology and in the sports Department. Many of our former students are medical practioners having their clinics close to our college. They voluntarily extend their services as and when needed.
