2. **South Korea**, during 1983-87, grew at 11 %

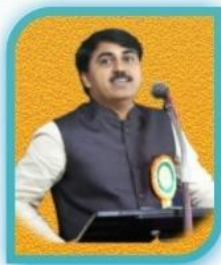
