I. Title: Live session on Union Budget 2026-27

II. Introduction:

The Department of Economics, Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidyalaya, Latur (Empowered Autonomous Institution), organized a Live Budget Session 2026–27 as a part of its Blended and Technology-Enabled Learning initiative. The programme aimed to connect students with real-time national economic policy-making through digital learning tools. The session was conducted on **2 February 2026** at the VLC Hall with active participation from students and staff.

A total of 37 students and staff participated in the session, including **14 male** and **23 female** students, along with **4 staff** members. The programme was organized under the guidance of **Dr. B. P. Gadekar**, Head Department of Economics.

IV. Details of Participants:

There were **37 participants** including **14 Male and 23 Females**.

V. Brief Summary of the Function:

The Department of Economics organized a live session on the Union Budget 2026-27 for UG and PG students at VLC Hall using a Blended and Technology-Enabled Learning System. A total of 37 students (14 males and 23 female) along with faculty members attended the session. The program combined offline classroom interaction with online live streaming, enabling students to experience the Budget presentation in real time.

Students watched the live telecast of the Finance Minister's: Hon. Nirmala Sitaraman Budget speech in the Lok Sabha through smart classroom facilities such as projector, internet connectivity,

connectivity, and audio-visual systems. Faculty members guided students in understanding the structure of the Budget and its economic implications. Students actively took notes, asked questions, and participated in discussions.

After the speech, an interactive discussion was conducted where students analyzed key budget provisions related to Education, Agriculture, Employment, and Development. The blended learning approach made the session more engaging, inclusive, and effective by integrating digital tools with traditional teaching methods.

The program successfully connected theoretical concepts with current economic policies and enhanced students analytical, digital, and policy interpretation skills.
