B) Report

I. Title: Welcome Ceremony of B.A.I and M.A.I Year students

II. Introduction:

On August 19, 2026, a vibrant Welcome Ceremony was organized at Hall No. 315 to warmly receive the newly admitted first-year students of the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) and Master of Arts (M.A.) programs. Commencing at 1:00 PM, the event served as an official platform to introduce new entrants to the institutional culture, academic atmosphere, and campus life. Hosted collaboratively by the senior cohorts M.A. Second, BA Third Year, and B.A. Second the gathering brought together students and faculty in an engaging atmosphere. The program aimed to ease transition anxieties, foster inter-batch camaraderie and instill a strong sense of community.

III. Objectives of Programme:

1. To formally welcome and orient first-year B.A. and M.A. students to the department and institution.
2. To facilitate positive social interactions and networking between senior and junior students.

V. Brief Summary of Programme:

The Welcome Ceremony began promptly at 1:00 PM in Hall No. 315, bringing together a total of 69 students alongside 4 dedicated staff members. Among the faculty present were Head of Department Dr. B. P. Gadekar, Prof. Jeevan Gaikwad, Prof. Rupali Jadhav and Prof. N. R. Walke. Their presence provided significant encouragement to the fresher's as well as the senior organizers. The event was meticulously planned and executed by the senior batches, specifically the M.A. Second, B.A. Third, and B.A. Second students. The senior student committee handled all logistics, stage management, venue decoration, activity scheduling to ensure a seamless experience for their incoming peers.

The program opened with a brief welcome address by the senior student representatives, followed by insightful words from Head of Department Dr. B. P. Gadekar. He welcomed the new cohort, emphasizing academic dedication, personal growth and holistic development during their university tenure. Prof. J. H. Gaikwad, Prof. Rupali Jadhav and Prof. N. R. VI. Conclusion, with Feedback on the Programme:

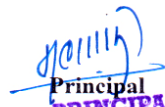

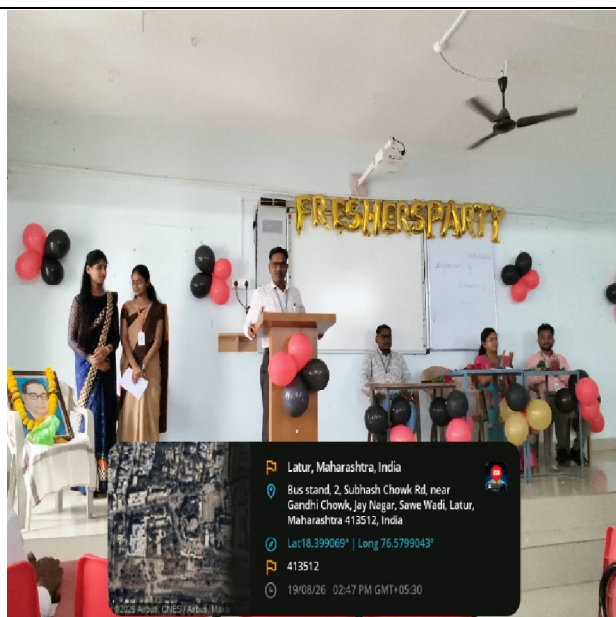

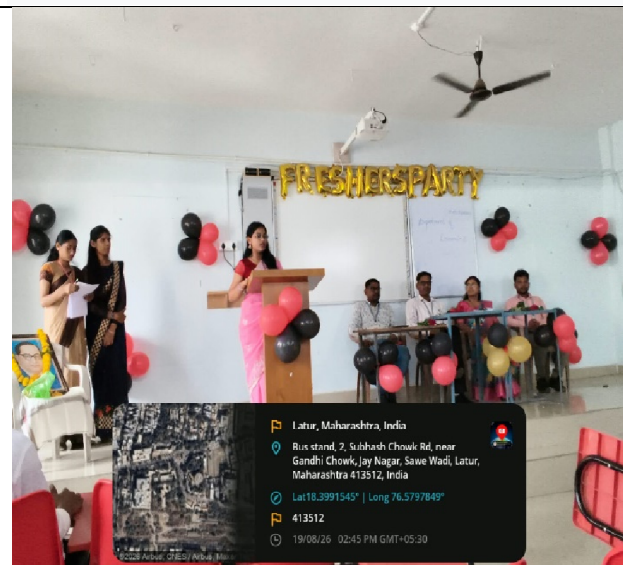
