#### i) Title:

### The Online National Level - Workshop on "War Journalism" ii)Introduction:

Principal Dr. Mahadev Gavhane of Rajarshi ShahuMahavidyalaya Autonomous, Latur, was present as chairperson of the inaugural function of the workshop. Dr. Narendra Vispute, (Assistant Director of Doordarshan Kendra, Mumbai) was present as chief guest. Dr. Rohit Kasbe (Y. C. M. O. University, Nashik) and Dr. Devendra Vispute (Head of Department of Defence and Strategic Studies, V. W. S. Arts, Commerce & Science College, Dhule) was present as resource person. Vice Principal Dr. Sadashiv Shinde, Prof. Shivshankar Patwari (Head, Department of Mass Communication & Journalism, Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidyalaya, Latur) and Dr. Ravindra Chincholkar (Head, M. C. J. Department, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur) was also present at this time.

#### v)Brief Summary of Events/Sessions:

Principal Dr. Mahadev Gavhane in his presidential address said that, no country in the world will need war if journalists and media work for world peace. Therefore journalist and media should contribute to bring peace. Dr. Ravindra Chincholkar delivered an introductory remark.

Dr. Devendra Vispute asserted that war journalism in India had not been able to develop properly due to the British-era tradition of concealment of defense matters from the public, extreme attempts at secrecy and red tapism in security forces. As a result, the public is still unaware of the defeat of 1962 China war. Things were changed a bit during the 1971 Bangladesh war, but the real impetus for the development of war journalism in India came after the 1998 Cargill conflict. At least 1,400 journalists have been killed in various wars and conflicts in the world since 1997, he said.







# Situation in India not conducive for war journalism, says Dr Devendra

Over 1200 journos died during war reporting in world

due to the present situation prevailing across the country which prevents the movement of the Indian Army from getting known to others.

He was speaking in a oneday national online workshop on War Journalism jointly organised by the department of mass communication and journalism at Rajarshi Shahu College, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar, Solapur University and Vidyavardhini Sabha College of Arts, Commerce and Science. Principal Dr Mahadev

Principal Dr Mahadev Gavhane presided over the programme. Dr Narendra Vispute, deputy director, doordarshan, Worli, Mumhai), Rohit Kashe (YCMOU, Nashik), viceprincipal Sadashiv Shinde were present as guests of honour.

Dr Vispute said that at least more than 1,200 journalists have been killed in many major and minor wars so far around the world. Hence, training in military operations is required for wartime journalism. Journalists in developed countries get many facilities including training but in India this field is still ignored. During the war journalism, journalists have to consider the balance of information given to the common man and a lot of human values, because if the picture of the devastation caused by the war is presented to the people, there is a danger of bad acts rather than good

राजर्षी शाह महाविद्यालयातील जनसंज्ञापन आणि वृत्तपत्रविद्या विभाग, पुण्यश्लोक अहिल्यादेवी होळकर सोलापुर विद्यापीठातील जनसंज्ञापन आणि वृत्तपत्रविद्या विभाग आणि विद्यावर्धिनी सभेचे कला वाणिज्य आणि विज्ञान महाविद्यालय, धुळे येथिल संरक्षण आणि सामरिक शास्त्र विभाग यांच्या संयुक्त विद्यमाने आयोजित युद्ध पत्रकारिता विषयावर आयोजित एक दिवसीय राष्ट्रीय ऑनलाईन कार्यशाळेत ते मुख्य वक्ते म्हणून बोलत होते. कार्यशाळेच्या अध्यक्षस्थानी महाविद्यालयाचे प्राचार्य डॉ. महादेव गव्हाणे तर प्रमुख मार्गदर्शक म्हणून डॉ. नरेंद्र विसपुते (उपसंचालक, दरदर्शन केंद्र वरळी मुंबई), डॉ. रोहीत कसबे (य.च.म.मू.विद्यापीठ, नाशिक) उपप्राचार्य प्रा. सदाशिव शिंदे यांची उपस्थिती होती. पढे बोलतांना त्यांनी आत्तापर्यंतच्या अनेक लहान मोठ्या युध्दात किमान १२०० पेक्षा अधिक पत्रकारांचा बळी गेला असून युध्दाच्या वेळी पत्रकारिता करण्यासाठी सैन्य

दलाकडून प्रशिक्षण घेणे आवश्यक असते. अशा प्रशिक्षणसाठी विकसीत देशात पत्रकारांना अनेक प्रकारच्या सुविधा मिळतात मात्र भारतात अद्यापही हे क्षेत्र दुर्लिक्षित राहीले असल्याचे सांगीतले. कार्यक्रमात मार्गदर्शक म्हणून बोलतांना डॉ. नरेंद्र विसप्ते यांनी युध्द पत्रकारिता करतांना पत्रकारांना सामान्यांना दिल्या जाणाऱ्या माहितीत समातोल आणि मोठ्या प्रमाणात मानवी मूल्यांचा विचार करावा लागतो, कारण युद्धामुळे घडन आलेल्या विनाशाचे चित्र लोकांसमोर ठेवले तर त्याचे चांगल्या ऐवजी बाईट परिणाम होण्याचा धोका असतो त्यामुळे वृद्ध पत्रकारिता संयमाने करावी लागते असे सांगीतले. तर डॉ. रोहीत कसबे यांनी युध्द पत्रकारिता आणि जागतिक घडामोडी यावर लक्ष केंद्रीत करून शत्रु आणि मित्र राष्ट्रे यांच्या सदंभातील ज्ञान. युध्दभूमीवर होत असलेल्या घडामोडी आणि त्याचे आपत्या राष्ट्रबर होणारे चांगले किंवा बाईट परिणाम या विषयी सतत जागरूक राहन वार्तांकन करावे लागते असे सांगीतले. कार्यक्रमाच्या अध्यक्षिय समारोपात प्राचार्य डॉ. महादेव गव्हाणे यांनी पत्रकारांनी आणि माध्यमांनी शांततेसाठी कार्य केले तर जगातील कोणत्याही देशाला युद्ध पत्रकारितेची आवश्यकता भासणार नाही म्हणून पत्रकारांनी आणि माध्यमांनी समाजात आणि पर्यायाने देशात शांतता प्रस्थापीत करण्यासाठी योगदान द्यावे असे विचार मांडले. कार्यक्रमाचे प्रास्ताविक डॉ. रविंद्र चिचोलकर यांनी केरने आभार सोलापूर विद्यापीठातील प्रा.डॉ.अंबादास मास्के यांनी मानले.
