Although June 27 is Helen Keller's birthday, the event was held as soon as the college started in July as the college had not started at that time. It was conducted on-line.

He lamented how the institutions and the society should be aware of Divyang. **Dr. Yogesh Niturkar** analyzed the need for empathy towards the disabled and how they can develop. He explained the various ways and means for this. **Dr. Madhav Shinde** introduced the important provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016. The principal of the college, **Dr. Mahadev Gavhane** was in the chair. In his presidential address, he gave examples of successful disabled people in the world and stressed that no person is ever weak. Head AND Convener **Prof. Priti Pohekar** conducted the program and **C. D. Bansode** thanked the students and professors from various disciplines for attending the event.
