Introduction:

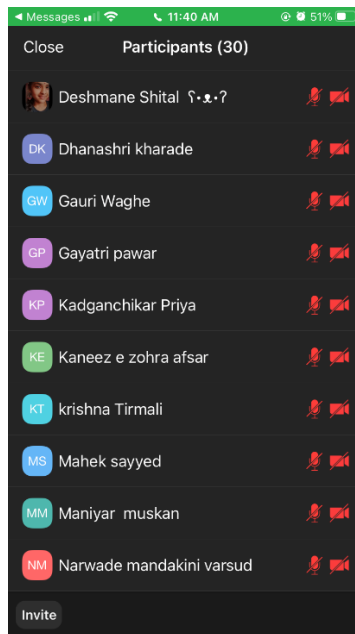
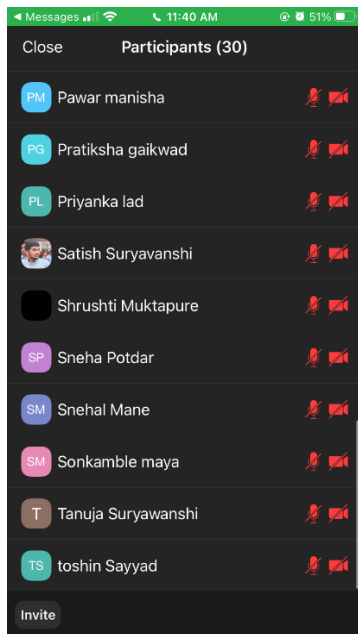
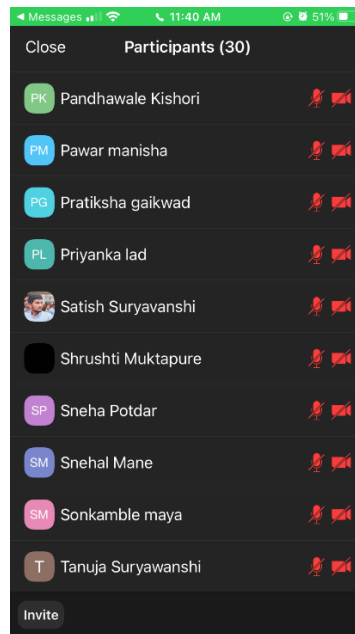
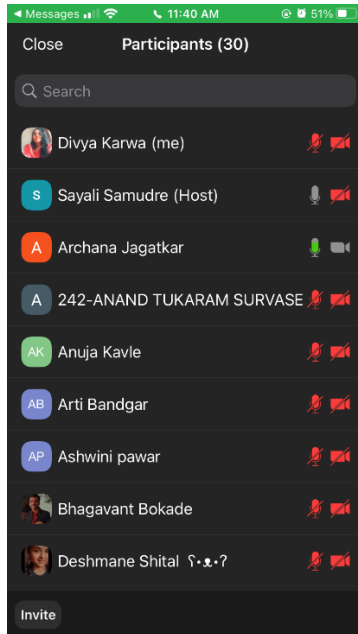

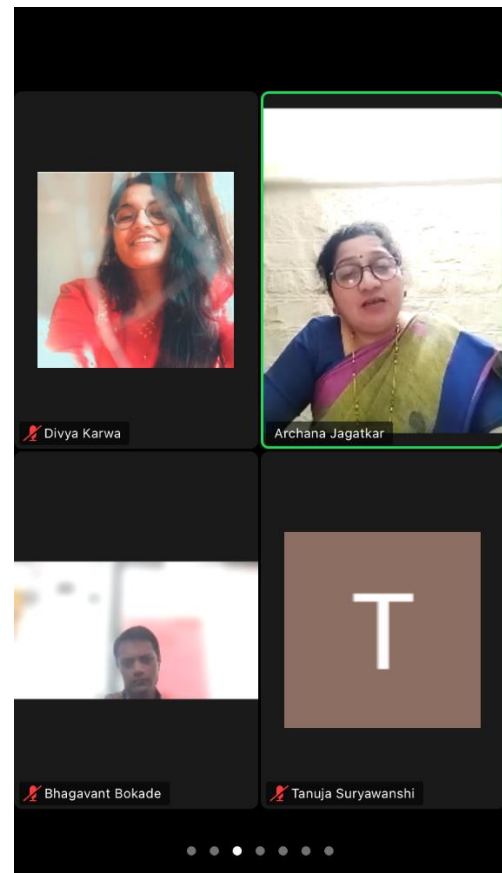
Details of Participants:
