We have got huge response from all over the India. Academicians, teaching faculties, Researchers, and students gave nice response to the workshop and participated very enthusiastically in interactive session

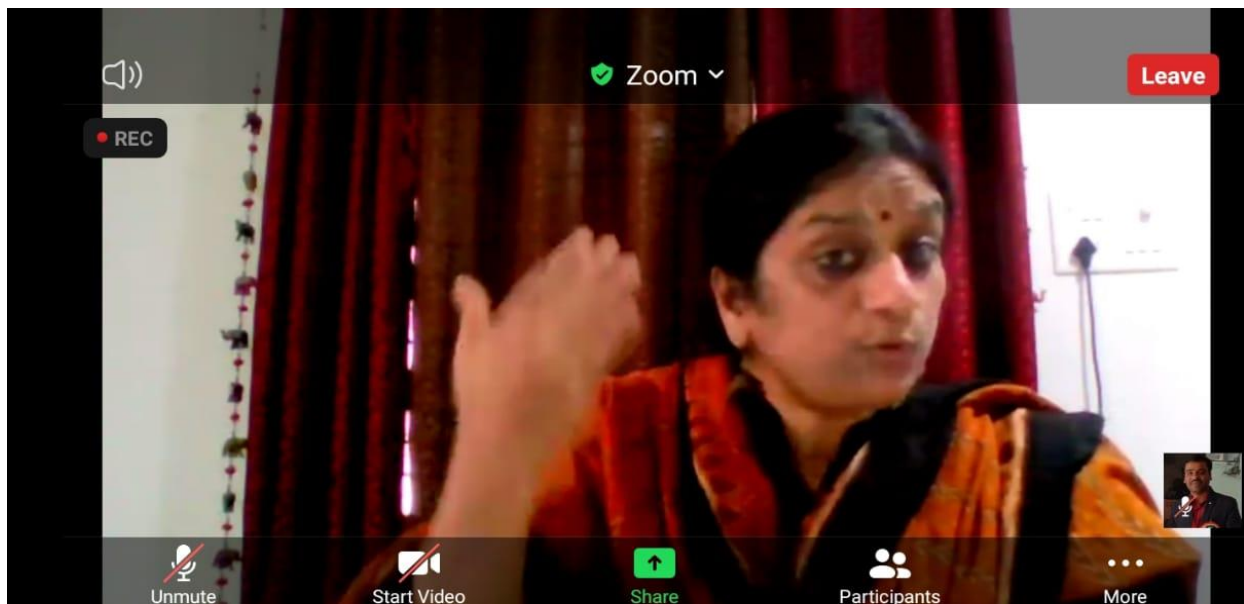
Brief Summary of Events/ Sessions:
