i. Title:**ii. Introduction:**

The Department of Sociology has conducted a Social Survey activity for the students in a slum area in Latur. The slum area was situated in Coil Nagar. The topic of the survey was based on the health and life of women. The sample of the survey were the women living in the slum area of Coil Nagar. The students were asked to study the health of women and their life, we wanted to track the changes brought in by Covid 19 in their lives and on their health. 3. To introduce to them the skill of creating questions and a way of asking them.

v. Brief Summary of Events/ Sessions-

Number of women interviewed: 10

Number of Questions asked: 07

Number of Students who interviewed the women: 26

10% women were agreed that covid-19 affected their family life and 90% of them disagrees. 70% women told that they earn for survival and 30% women did not work for survival. 100% women told that they were not Covid positive. 90% women told that they have not physically suffered by Covid-19 and 10% women told they have suffered from it. 60% women told that their family life was suffered by covid-19 and 40% women were not agreed with this. 40% women told that because of covid-19 they have to lose their job and 60% women were not agreed with this. 30% women accepted that they felt, very irritated by people's behavior with them during covid-19 and 70% disagreed this.

It seems that covid-19 affected socially, physically, economically to women's health and life. And it also affected their family life.

vi. Conclusion, with Feedback on the Programme:

It was a learning experience for the students and they have got an opportunity to participate in field work through this social survey.
