i. Title: 'No vehicle Day'

ii. Introduction:

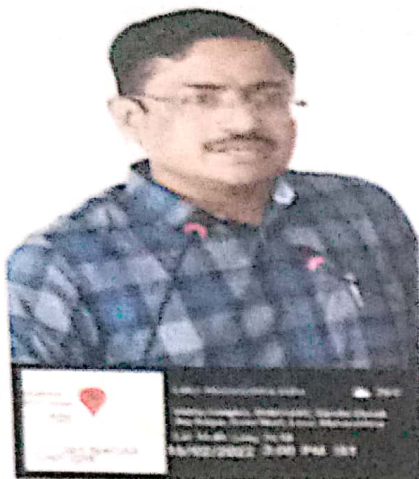

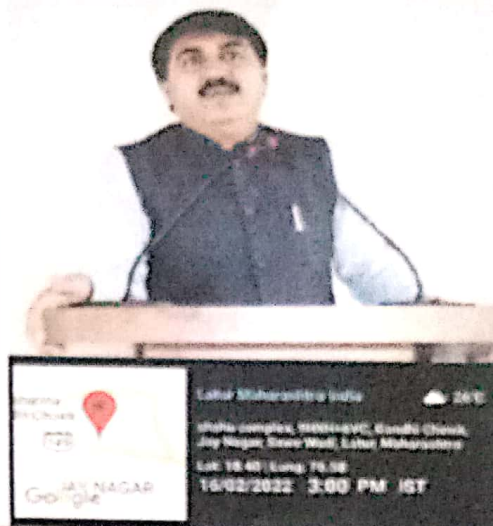
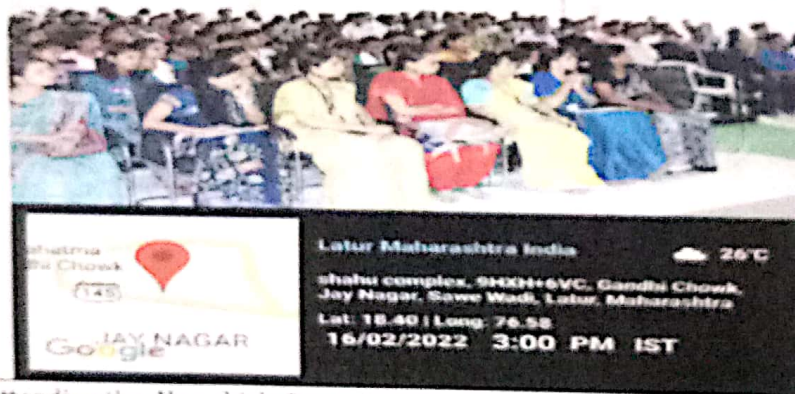


Photo. Dr.M.H.Gavhane , Principal ,Addressing the staff members on No vehicle Day in V.L.C. Date:16.02.2022
