Ganesh Chaturthi, also called Vinayaka Chavithi, is an auspicious Hindu festival which is celebrated for 10 days every year. The festival is celebrated in the Bhadra month as per the Hindu calendar which generally falls in mid-August to September. It marks the birthday of the beloved elephant-headed Lord Ganesha. The excitement of Ganesh Chaturthi settles in weeks before the festival actually begins. Artisans start preparing idols of Ganesha in different poses and sizes. The Ganesha idols are installed in beautifully decorated 'pandal' at homes, temples or localities. The statue is also decorated with flowers, garlands and lights. The bidding farewell to Ganesha known as Ganpati Visarjan, a ceremony wherein the statue is now immersed in water. Due to this activity water get polluted.

Collected Ganesh Murties were handed over to Latur Mucipal corporation.


vi) Conclusion with feedback on the Programme:
