 ii) Introduction : Household surveys are one of the most important sources of social and demographic statistics of villages. While housing censuses are also a key source of such statistics. Household sample surveys — which can investigate almost any populationbased subject — are therefore a powerful alternative, becoming one of the most flexible sources of data on social phenomena in the last few decades.
