ii. **Introduction** Every year on November 21, World Fisheries Day is commemorated to raise awareness about the fishing industry's environmental issues. Fishing is the capture of aquatic organisms in marine, coastal and inland areas. Marine and inland fisheries, together with aquaculture, provide food, nutrition and a source of income to around 820 million people around the world, from harvesting, processing, marketing and distribution. For many it also forms part of their traditional cultural identity. One of the greatest threats to the sustainability of global fishery resources is illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing. In 2019-20, with an overall production of 142 lakh tons, India produced 8% of the global share. During the same time period, India's fisheries exports stood at Rs 46,662 crore, constituting about 18% of India's agricultural exports. India aims to achieve a target of producing 22 million metric tonnes of fish by 2024-25.

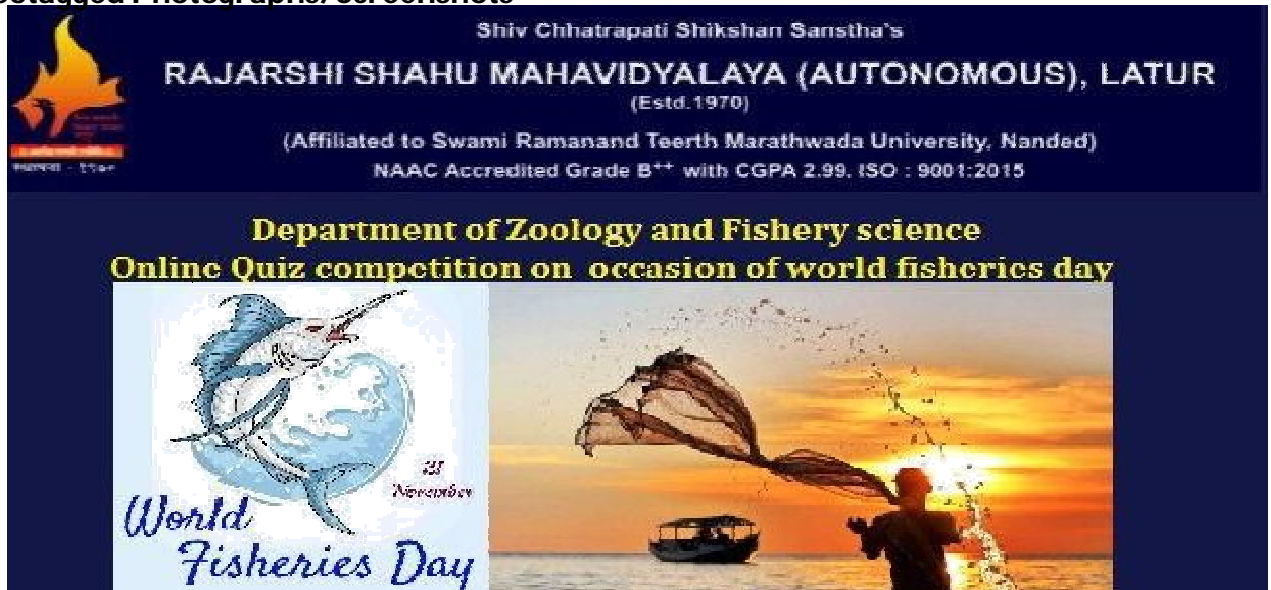
