B) Report

i) Title:Poster Presentation on the Occasion of World Elephant Day

ii) Introduction:

Colleges and educational institutions play an important role in creating environmental awareness and promoting the conservation of endangered species. The **Department of Zoology and Fishery Science**, Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidyalaya (Autonomous), Latur, actively engages in organizing programs that spread awareness about wildlife protection and biodiversity conservation.

On the occasion of **World Elephant Day**, celebrated annually on **August 12**, the Department organized a **Poster Presentation and Awareness Program** to highlight the significance of elephants in maintaining forest ecosystems and to promote their protection against threats such as habitat loss and poaching.

The program aimed to instill in students a sense of responsibility toward wildlife conservation and to educate them on the vital ecological role of elephants as keystone species.

v) Brief Summary of Events:

The **Department of Zoology and Fishery Science** organized the **Poster Presentation** on **August 12, 2025**, in celebration of **World Elephant Day**. The program commenced

with an **introductory session** emphasizing the theme “**Protect Elephants, Protect Nature**,” underscoring the importance of elephants in maintaining ecological integrity. Faculty members delivered short talks on the significance of elephants as “ecosystem engineers,” explaining how they contribute to seed dispersal and forest regeneration. Students prepared **creative and informative posters** depicting elephants’ life cycles, conservation issues, and the need to end poaching and illegal ivory trade. Judging was based on creativity, relevance, and scientific content. The event concluded with **certificates of appreciation** distributed to participants and winners, reinforcing the department’s commitment to environmental and wildlife education.

vi) Conclusion:

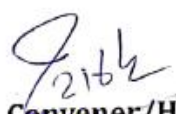
