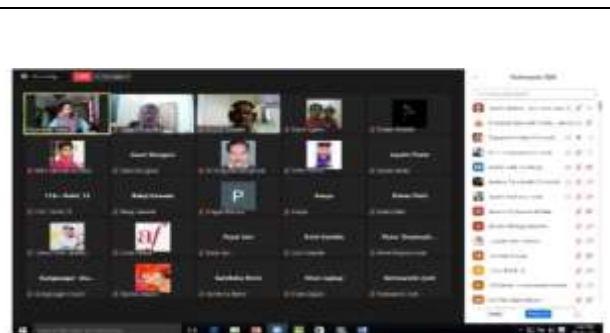

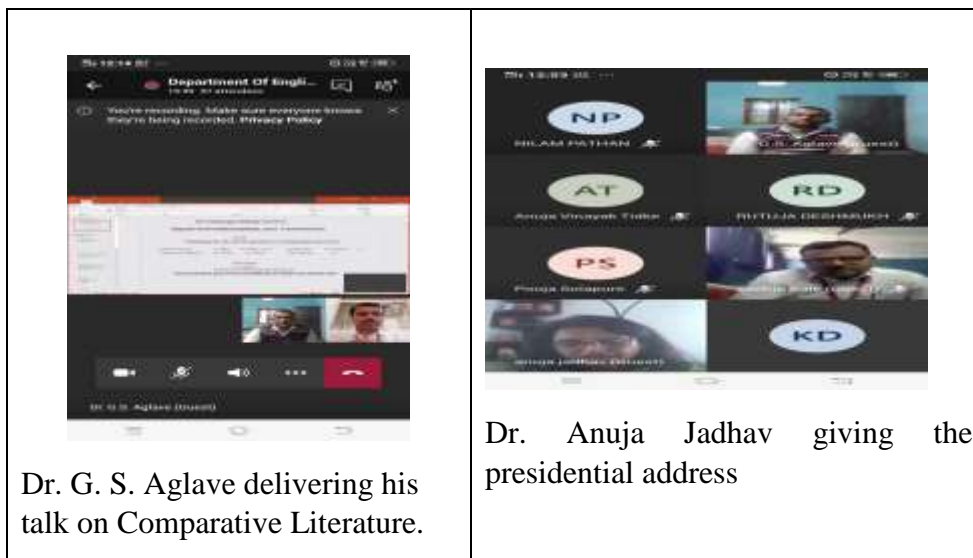

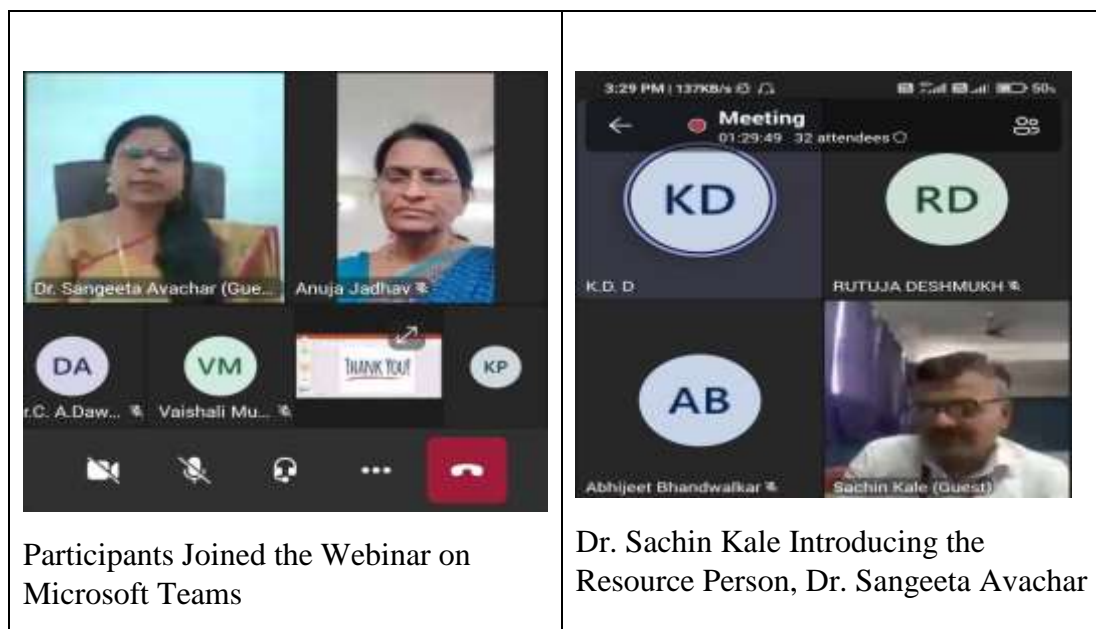
Workshop for UG & PG Students on Comparative Literature
