Part – A : The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement and the outcome achieved by the end of the year :

In the Quality Advisory Committee of IQAC meeting held on 20-04-2007, Teaching, Non-teaching, Management Members along with outside advisors unanimously decided to implement UGC-CPE scheme. Emphasis should be given, while implementing the scheme to Networking of all the Departments using Wi-Fi technology and E-learning centre and purchase instruments under inter disciplinary scheme. It is also decided to establish Language Laboratory.

Under UGC's innovative programmers M.Sc (Photonics) course should be started. This will be a unique course in the State of Maharashtra.

It was also proposed in the meeting that Remedial Courses and Coaching Classes for entry into services for SC / ST and minority students should be started under UGC scheme.

We decided to visit Natural Sugar & Allied Industries at Ranjani (Dist. Osmanabad) to see the the working of ISO 9001-2000 .

College should apply for autonomy and as a part of preparedness for this a National Conference on “Aspects of Academic Autonomy in Higher Education” should be organized in which Resource Persons should be invited from reputed autonomous colleges.

A science exhibition under parent university's “Avishkar” should be organized in the college and college should generate resources for developmental work. It is also decided to go for ISO 9001-2000 certification.

We are happy to note that we could connect all the Departments through Wi-Fi network as well as establish e-learning centre with broadband internet facility. This facility is given free of cost to all the students and teachers. We have purchased instruments under inter disciplinary program under UGC-CPE Scheme and established Language Lab having 21 computer nodes with relevant software.

We have introduced M.Sc. (Photonics) course under UGC's innovative programmes and could also introduce Remedial Course and Coaching Classes for entry into services for SC / ST and minorities.

We could organize National Conference on "Aspects of Academic Autonomy in Higher Education" but could not apply for autonomy in this academic year. We'll certainly apply for it in the next academic year. A team comprising of management members, senior teachers and office staff visited Natural Sugar and Allied Industries Rajani, Dist Osmanabad to study ISO 9001-2000 certification.

"Avishkar" Science exhibition under the aegis of our parent university was organized in our college.

We could generate Rs.502461/- as internal resources for the developmental work.

We had decided to invite Dr.Vijay Bhatkar, father of Indian super computer, at our college . Unfortunately, we could not achieve this.

Part – B

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

Pursuit of Excellence is the mission of our institution. We, therefore, strictly adhere to transparency in the conduct of examinations and in financial matters. Every year one degree college teacher, one junior college teacher and one non- teaching staff member is honoured by the management with "Shahu Shree" award. This is a glorious tradition followed by us. Our college has completely banned private coaching by our teachers, so that they can devote all their energy for the development of the college. It is a matter of pride for all of us that in our college, selection of teachers is done on the basis of merit alone. In order to develop overall personality of the students, we regularly arrange Shahu Lecture series on socially relevant subjects for which we invite not only academicians but also politicians and social reformers.

Recently college has created orphan fund amounting to Rs 11 Lakh in honour of our retired Principal Dr. R. L. Kavle. All the expenses of four orphan students will be borne by the college from the academic year 2008-09 under this scheme. We have also raised another fund while felicitating Adv. Narayanraoji Patil, Secretary of the Management since 1968, on the occasion of his completing 75 years of age. Out of this fund, we provide scholarships to 12 students having rural background every year amounting to Rs .12000/-

Earn and Learn scheme is one of the unique features of the college. We have collected Rs16 Lakh from alumni and well wishers of our former Principal A.S. Jadhav and the scheme is run under his name. Nearby 60 needy students take benefit of this scheme every year. In addition to these schemes, fee concessions are given at the time of admission for students belonging to the economically weaker sections of the society.

A set of special study material is given to meritorious students. We also run coaching classes for various Competitive examinations under “Shahu Prabodhini” In collaboration with an NGO “Flight Cadet Prasad Shendge Memorial Trust” lectures of Army Personnel are arranged every year. As part of community services, we organize through NSS, NCC units, Vivek Vahini, Andhashraddha Nirmulan Samiti and students associations, various socially useful activities such as blood donation, tree plantation , rural cleanliness drive, health and hygiene in rural areas and in the slums of Latur township.

For the welfare of the employees, we have Employees Co-operative Credit Society which gives loans on concessional rate. An Employees’ Welfare Fund is also in operation.

2. New Academic Programmes Initiated (UG and PG) :

As need of the day and as per our plan to start courses having demand in the market, we have started M.Sc.(Photonics) course in this academic year under UGC’s innovative programmes with an intake capacity of 20 students. Our Geography Department has been recognized as Research Centre by our parent university because of which we have started Ph.D. programme in Geography.

3. Innovations in Curricular Design and Transaction :

- The B.A.I,II, and III year students of public administration have organized seminars and they have also presented model in “Avishkar” a university level research exhibition in the college.
- The students of B.A. public administration have participated in “Avishkar – Social Science Exhibition”.
- Shri.S.S.Bhandwalkar, HOD History and Shri.M.R.Patil, Lecturer in History have participated in workshop on new syllabus for UG- Classes.
- A project work paper in History has been introduced for B.A. III year.

- Shri. S. S. Bhandwalkar is the author and publisher of a text book on “History of Modern India” for second year junior college course.
- An Historical tour has been conducted for B.A. III year students. Department of History conducts seminars for students of B.A.
- Department of Economics has allotted project work for PG- students.
- An industrial tour for UG and PG students of Economics has been organized by the Economics Department.
- The Department of Economics has conducted seminars for students of UG /PG classes.
- The students of M.A. Final year of Geography have prepared project Reports on various topics.
- As per the university norms, all UG- final year students complete project work on environmental studies.
- Dr. S.J. Phule of Geography is the author of XII Std. Geography Text Book.
- Department of Geography has organized educational tour for UG and PG students.
- The students of M.A. II (Geography) have conducted geographical survey of the village Yelwat under Latur district.
- A seminar programme for students of M.A.II & M.Phil. under Geography department has been organized. The PG students of Geography have also participated in science fare.
- Under our Arts faculty co-ordination wing, oral presentation and seminars by students have been organized.
- In all the three faculties i.e. Arts, Science and Commerce, the assessment of teachers by students is undertaken through regular monthly feedback and open discussion with students .
- Faculty wise co ordination committee meetings are arranged in each term in which discussion on feedback about the assessment of teachers by students is undertaken and remedial measures planned accordingly.
- A study tour based on syllabus was arranged for M.A. I, & II (Sanskrit)students to “Vaidik Sanskrit Pathshala” for one day.

- The Department of Marathi has organized seminars by students of BA. III. The department also organizes training programmes to develop debate and elocution skills.
- 27 students of B.A. III Functional English have successfully completed project works on various topics.
- A one day educational tour to Yedsi and Ter in neighbouring Osmanabad district was organized by Department of English on 13.01.2008 for the students of BA II (English).
- The students B.A. First year Functional English have conducted group survey on various aspects.
- Department of English also organizes student seminars for UG-classes
- A language laboratory has been set up by the college for the benefit of all the language departments of the college, under the UGC-CPE grant during the year 2006-2007. Department of English has efficiently used the facilities available in the language laboratory to develop listening, speaking, and reading skills among the students of English.

Our Department of Library and Information Science has provided guidance to B.Lib./M.Lib. students for their project work and the projects were displayed in the exhibition arranged for the students of Library and Information Science.

Students of B.Lib/M.Lib are encouraged to develop their skills through (i) Retrieval of data from OPAC (ii) Information search through internet by using various search engines (iii) Participation in elocution and debating competitions (iv) Evaluation of reference books and material (v) Students are encouraged to appear for various competitive examinations (vi) Encourage to develop reading culture & reading habit. (vii) Personality and career development programmes.

In our YCMOU centre, the Foundation, UG/ PG courses are based on self-study oriented curriculum, practical oriented syllabus, employment –oriented curriculum, curriculum as per changing time and need, flexibility in syllabi. A workshop on syllabus framing in commerce under YCMOU was organized in which our staff member Dr. A. J. Raju and Shri K. D. Mirje participated. The Foundation as well as UG/PG course students of YCMOU are required to complete their project workbook in specific time period.

Seminars of P.G. students are organized at the end of each semester. Class tests, home assignments and pre-annual examination are conducted for assessment and evaluation of students. Feed back from students is regularly taken and their grievance/ suggestions are taken into consideration. Students suggestions are conveyed to the concerned teachers for the benefit of teaching-learning process.

In addition to seminars, viva voce, group discussions are arranged in the classes in order to develop soft skills of the students.

- (i) Annual Teaching Plan : At the beginning of the academic year Annual Teaching Plan is submitted by every teacher for the subject(s) taught by him/her.
- (ii) Daily Teaching Report : Daily Teaching Report is maintained by the teachers in their academic diary provided by the college to every teacher.
- (iii) Monthly Teaching Report : At the end of every month, the daily teaching report maintained by the teacher is verified by the Vice Principal of concerned faculty.
- (iv) Attendance: Attendance of students is recorded daily in the attendance book and the names of students whose attendance is below 75 % are submitted at the end of every month to the Vice Principal for necessary action.
- (v) Term Tests : Term Tests were conducted during the first term (before Dipawali) and in the second Term on the basis of the syllabus completed during the said term(s)
- (vi) Seminars: Seminars of P.G. students (M. Com) were arranged at the end of every semester and the performance of the students was evaluated by the concerned teachers.
- (vii) Pre annual Examination : Pre annual examination was conducted and meritorious students were given cash prizes. A set of text books for the entire year is given to the students based on their result to meritorious students.

Results were analyzed at coordination meetings.

Cash Prizes were given to toppers in the examination. Attendance Reports and test marks were sent every month to student's parents through office.

In addition to this, Blood Donation Camp, Elocution Competition, Rangoli Competition, Handwriting Competition were organized.

Assessment of Teachers by students is done at the end of every year through response sheets and action is taken accordingly. Monthly feedback regarding teaching and syllabus completion is taken and corrective measures are adopted .

At the beginning of academic year, last year's results are analyzed in the coordination committee meeting. Finalization of subject combinations is also done in this meeting.

M.Sc. (Photonics) syllabus is framed in collaboration with experts from ISP and CUSAT.

B.Sc. (T.Y.) students have completed projects in Physics. The B.Sc. (Physics) and M.Sc.(Photonics) students have prepared projects for exhibition on the topics : Solar Water Heater cum Cooker, Green House Effect for Better Efficiency of Solar Water Heating and TiO₂ Graphite Solid Liquid Junction Solar Cells. Dr. E. U. Masumar has written a text book on Physics. Dr. C.S. Mali, Head of Physics and Electronics Department, is involved in framing the syllabi of M. Sc. Photonics. The M.Sc.(Photonics) students have regularly presented seminars on the projects completed by them.

Dr. C.S. Mali has worked as coordinator for the University level Research festival “Avishkar 2007” organized by our parent university. In this festival our U.G. and P.G. students took active part. Three Research Projects of our college were selected by the University for the State Level “Avishkar 2007” Festival held at SNDT University Mumbai.

A Project on Green House Effect for better efficiency of solar heating was selected for zonal exhibition for P.G. students held at STM University, Nagpur and the same project was also selected for National Exhibition held at University of Pune (May 2008) This project has also won first prize in the state level science exhibition for P.G. students held at Balbhim college, Beed, on September 1, 2007.

A seminar programme for B.Sc III Analytical chemistry students has been undertaken under the guidance of Dr. S.D. Salunke.

Mr.S.N.Shinde ,HOD Botany has written two text books.

A short one day tour of B.Sc. (Botany) students was organized to Kava village for field survey of rare plant species.

A seminar entitled Shape-U was organized for B.Sc.(T.Y.) Microbiology students. Mrs. R. M. Reddy, a teacher of zoology, has written two text books. A study tour to Gharni Fish Farm for B.Sc.TY (Zoology) students was organized in which 35 students took benefit and in which District In charge fisheries officer, Mr. Jalil Patel, has given guidance. Separate class tests and seminars have been conducted in which 10 B.Sc.(F.Y.), 10 B.Sc.(S.Y.) and 11 B.Sc. (T.Y.) students presented their seminar on various topics related to Zoology and Fishery Science.

A science exhibition of various scientific models and posters was organized by the faculty of science for B.Sc.(T.Y.) students on 26th January, 2007 in which 39 projects were displayed.

53 Projects were completed by UG/ PG (Biotech) students and 42 seminars were organized by UG/PG (Biotech) students. Field visit to Basar in March 2008 was organized for M.Sc(Biotech) students. A training programme was successfully completed by M.Sc(Biotech) final year student Miss Swati Kadam at NCCS, Pune, Mr. Patil Amol and Jahagirdar Adwait at CCBM, Hyerabad and M.ScF.Y(Biotech) student K. Manisha at Kerala Agricultural University. Our M.Sc.F.Y.(Biotech) students Miss.Meher Akshaya and Sayali Patil presented project at State Level Exhibition at Beed on September 1, 2007 and University level Avishkar Festival held in our college on December 1 and 2, 2007 and at Avishkar State Level festival held at S.N.D.T. University Mumbai in January 2008 and also at Anveshan West Zonal Festival held at Nagpur on 14 to 16 March, 2008.

Students of B.Sc. and M.Sc (Biotech) have participated in four National level conferences/ symposia.

Department of Computer science & IT has conducted two unit tests and a pre-semester exam in each semester for UG/ PG courses . Toppers were rewarded with cash prizes and poor performers and failures are penalized. Internal marks for B.C.A. and B.Sc (CS) students are given on the basis of following criteria : i) Marks obtained for each subject in pre-semester exam (ii) Marks obtained in each subject for unit tests (iii) Last semester university exam percentage (iv) Attendance in theory as well as for practical.

A software has been developed by Mrs.K.M.Pradhan, HOD Comp Sci. and IT, for B.Sc.(C.S) and B.C.A. examinations for their internal assessment. The Department has successfully conducted online examination of H.S.C. Board for 118 students.

Teachers of Comp. Sc & IT regularly organize seminars for teachers. This year seminar on Wireless Technology, Switching Techniques, J2ME, Touch-Screen, Working with flex grid control, Web Camera, Face Recognition System and .NET Framework were organized. One workshop on Compiler Design was also organized. As part of effective administration, coordination and harmony in the Department, Teachers of Comp. Sc & IT daily interact in the meeting between 10.15 to 10.30 am

4. Inter-disciplinary programmes started :

As a part of inter disciplinary programme under UGC's CPE Scheme, we have developed a common instrumentation facility centre where in we have provided a UV-visible spectrophotometer, Flame Photometer and Arc-emission Spectrometer. This facility is made available to the research scholars working in all science departments.

5. Examination reforms implemented :

Under our Arts, Science and Commerce coordination wings, term wise two tests and one Pre-Annual Examinations in the month of February for non semester courses and pre semester exams for semester courses are conducted as per university exam pattern. Absent students are penalized while meritorious students are rewarded with cash prizes in these exams.

In the beginning of the academic year, a meeting of staff members is arranged in which, on the basis of previous year result analysis, the students with better academic prospects are identified in each subject and are given special attention towards their progress throughout the academic year. The reasons for poor performance are also identified and rectification measures are chalked out. A monthly attendance report and term wise test results are communicated to parents.

26. Increase in the infrastructural facilities:

- The Department of Economics is enriched with a computer with internet facility, furniture and books.

- As an innovative approach under CPE Scheme, a “Language Laboratory” has been set up for the benefit of students of all Language Departments viz. English, Marathi, Hindi, Russian, Pali and Sanskrit. It is equipped with adequate software, black board and 22 computers.

- The department of Hindi is allotted with a separate Department office with furniture.
- Department of Library and Information Science has established DVBS Technology in collaboration with YCMOU, Nashik and ISRO, Ahmedabad.
- Our Library unit is enriched with C-band type SITRF and base band equipment, student end peripheral equipment, video capture computer, video handy cam with tripod, wireless handheld microphone, multimedia projector, Speakers, OSPREY Card worth Rs 3,24,508/- and furniture (chairs, tables) worth Rs 38,400/-.
- Commerce faculty has a separate commerce Lab with broad band internet facility having 30 nodes.
- Our photonics Department has established four new well equipped Labs with some of the major, advanced equipments such as OTDR, Microwave bench, GM counter, Spray coating unit, Arc Emission Spectroscopic set up (PC based) and Holography set up.

Internet (Broad band) facility with printer is made available to Physics, Electronics and Photonics units. In case of power failure inverter facility is made available to both the units.

Our Chemistry and Analytical chemistry Laboratory is enriched with additional advanced instrument such as pH Meter, Conductometer, Potentiometer,

UV-Visible Spectrophotometer (under Interdisciplinary Scheme of UGC–CPE).
Water Distillation Unit, Centrifuge Machine, Electronic balance and Flame Photometer.

Department of Chemistry and Analytical Chemistry has been provided with computer connected to broad band internet facility.

A computer with broad band internet connectivity is provided to Botany Department.

Dept of Microbiology has purchased electronic balance (CONTECH) worth Rs. 52575/- and Vacuum Cleaner worth Rs.5200/-, Dept. of Zoology and Fishery Science has purchased BoD incubator worth Rs.55,575/-. The Department is also equipped with broad band internet.

Dept of Biotechnology has a separate building with well equipped spacious 12 Laboratories with all advanced instrumental and other necessary facilities. The department has a separate administrative unit.

The said department has recently purchased equipments worth Rs.34,71,020/-. Dept of Computer Science and IT has enriched its Lab with LCD Projector, DVD writer and Laser printer worth Rs 61002/-

27. Technology upgradation:

- Each department in the college is provided with a computer having broad band internet facility.
- The broad band internet connectivity is also provided to teachers console in the Language Laboratory for teachers of English and other languages.
- The computer lab of our Library is equipped with 10 terminals with broad band internet connectivity.
- Broadband internet facility is provided to the Department of Library and Information Science.
- The facilities for interaction between students and subject experts through EDUSAT in collaboration with YCMOU & ISRO have been enhanced.
- Our library has purchased the advanced LCD projector with DVBS Technology.
- Physics Lab is equipped with Hall Effect Measurement Setup, Optical Research Bench, Fiber Optics Lab Setup, Laser Sound Detectors, Zeeman and Arc

Emission Spectroscope, Michaelson & Fabriperot Interferometer, microprocessors and PC based Micro Controller Kits, Microwave Oven and Vanderpaw Four Probe Setup.

- Computer connectivity (with broad band) is made available to the Department of Microbiology.
- Under UGC- CPE scheme, an UV- visible spectrophotometer has been purchased under Interdisciplinary scheme. This instrument is being used by different Science Departments.
- Dept of Biotechnology has purchased following advanced instruments : PCR, Geldoc, Sequecel, Z-D electrophoresis and fermentor.
- Two labs of Comp Science & IT Department have broad band internet connectivity to all the nodes.

28. Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students :

We have provided broad band internet access to all the Departments. This facility is provided free of cost. In addition to this, other departments viz. Library, Commerce Lab, IT centre are also provided with adequate nodes with broadband internet connectivity. We have a separate E- learning centre where we have appointed two computer teachers who train teachers as well as students, if they have any difficulty in handling computer. Every day approximately 100 students visit our e-learning centre.

29. Financial aid to students :

The meritorious students in term tests and pre-annual examinations are rewarded with cash prizes, besides their regular state and central government merit scholarships. Economically weaker and deserving students are given fee concession at the time of admission. Another unique feature of our scheme is that some of our staff members and local philanthropists adopt students from economically weaker sections of the society and meet their entire educational expenditure. Under our “Principal A.S.Jadhav Unique Earn and Learn Scheme” around 60 students from landless , economically weaker and labour class families are identified and are encouraged to earn through remunerative work in the college premises to meet their educational expenditure. The remuneration for such students is given from the

interest earned through a fund of Rs.16 lakh collected from alumni and well wishers of our former Principal A.S. Jadhav.

In the academic year 2007-08, the college has created orphan fund of Rs. 11 Lakh from our alumni and well wishers in honour of our recently retired Principal Dr. R. L. Kavle. The said scheme is proposed to be implemented from academic year 2008-09 for the benefit of four orphan students to be adopted by the college and the college will meet all their educational expenses through the interest earned out of this fund.

Another scholarship scheme is also implemented for the students hailing from exclusively rural areas. The funds for the said scheme have been raised while felicitating Adv. Narayanraoji Patil who is Secretary of Shiv Chhatrapati Shikshan Sanstha, our parent institute since 1968, on the occasion of completion of 75 years of his age. Through this scheme 12 students are benefited each year with an assistance of Rs.1000/- each.

30. Activities and support from the Alumni Association:

Every year new members are added to our alumni association as all pass out UG / PG students are registered as members. This helps us to generate internal resources, which we use for the developmental work.

31. Activities and support from the Parent-Teacher Association:

A common meeting of parents in the beginning of academic year/ at least once in the academic year, is organized in which issues relevant to students' difficulties are taken for discussion.

32. Health Services :

First aid is available in the Departments of Sports, Zoology & Fishery Science, Chemistry & Analytical Chemistry and Microbiology. In the event of minor health problems, we use the first aid kits kept at the Departments mentioned above and then seek help from clinics which are situated very close to our college run by our former students. Some of our management members are medical professionals who provide medical service to us.

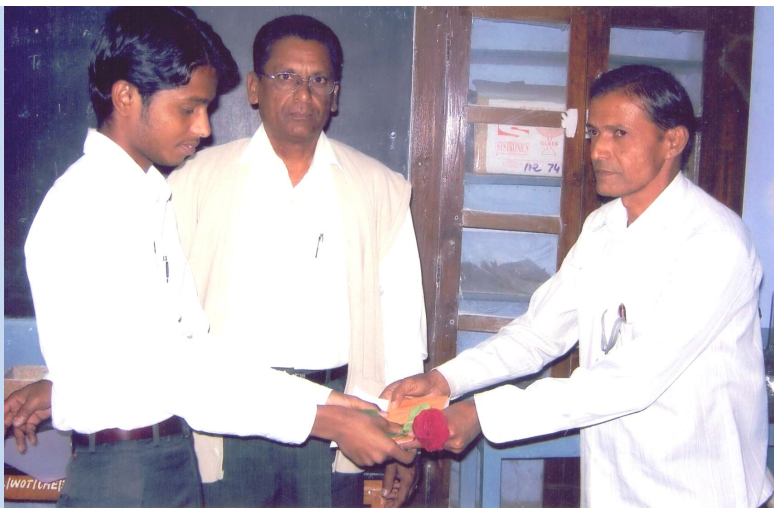

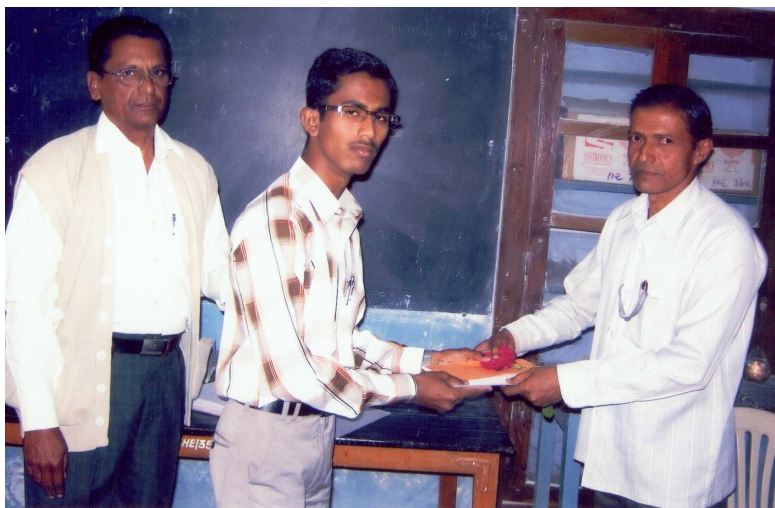

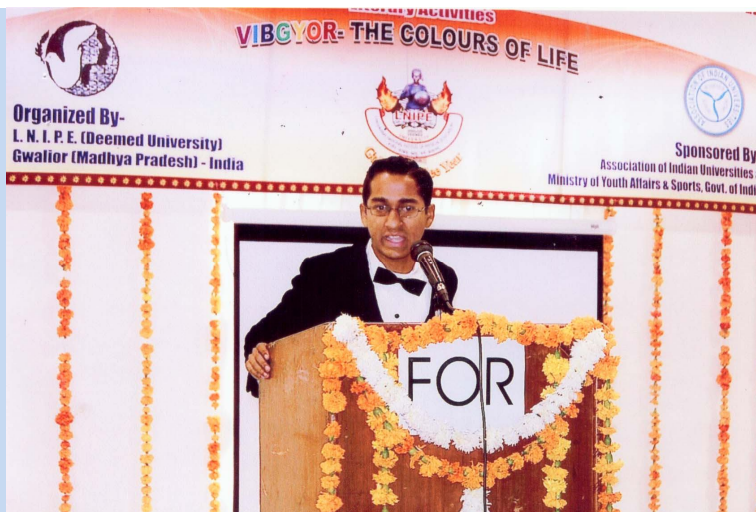

Hostel Facility :

Ladies Hostel has an intake capacity of 120. There are 60 rooms with solar heater, generator, water softener, intercom, furniture set, cupboard, bed, fan and mess facility. There are eight office bearers who look after the hostel unit. At least four meetings of local management committee are arranged.

In the Boys Hostel there are 38 rooms and one auditorium. The hostel accommodates 78 students. The Boys Hostel is meant for poor students who come under our 'Earn and Learn' scheme. The students are charged only Rs.200/- per month. These student get the benefit / facility of bed, electricity, cycle stand , safe drinking water, spacious ground and garden in Yoga Training Camp was organised for these students. From the next academic year (i.e. June 2008) we want to start boarding facility on concessional rate. Hostel committee meeting takes place every month. There are 5 office bearers to look after the Boys Hostel.

Earn and Learn Scheme :

We have deposited Rs. 16 lakh in the name of Principal A.S.Jadhav under Earn and Learn Scheme. The interest earned on the deposit is used for the scheme. This year 52 students took benefit of the scheme. We have spent Rs. 1,36,000/- under the said scheme.

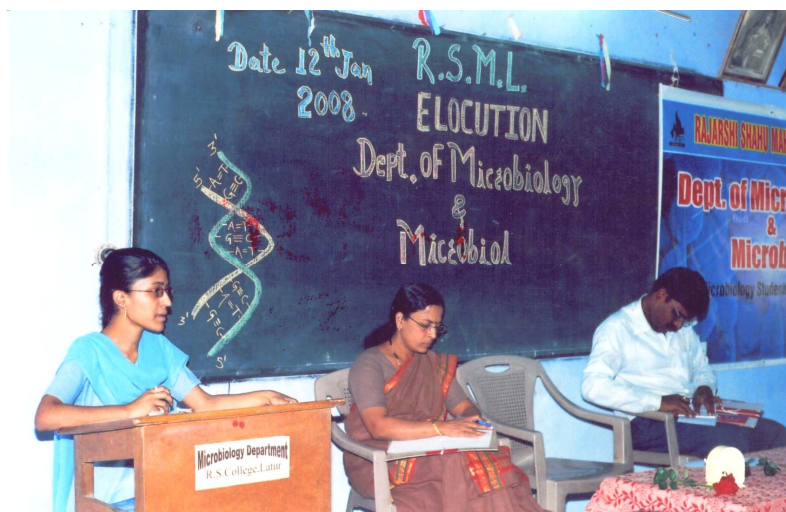
