- Interspecific or interspecific
- An organism compete for resources from zygote stage up to natural death
- Competition is structural force for Succession

1) Exploitation

- Indirectly compete for same limited resources
- Each tries to consume as much as possible
- least common

Interference

- Directly compete for resources
- Direct fight
- Stronger survive
- Take advantage

Apparent

- Two species do not compete for same resources but they have at
- least one natural enemy due to which the compete indirectly
- One species harm's itself in a way that other species being harmed more
