NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

### **CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties, being united by common interests and objectives, will establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institutions** and its related Departments/Constituents. - 2.9.1 ELTIS Teachers will conduct the session for a class of 24 students for English Language courses and a class of 20 students for Foreign Language courses, nor less nor more. The day, time and duration could be decided at mutual convenience.

- d. Assessment and evaluation charges are included in the course fee.
- e. For Foreign Language courses, there will be one mid-term test and one final term test. The formats of the same will be decided mutually in due course.

### 2.9.5 Certification:

Students who have 85% attendance and scored 60% aggregate marks will be eligible for a joint certification by ELTIS/SIFIL, Symbiosis (SIU/ELTIS) and RSM.

- 2) Any changes of the location of the programs shall be mutually agreed upon by the parties.
- 3) It is understood that the details of joint activities/conditions for utilization of results achieved, the arrangement for specific visit/exchange and all other forms of co-operation will be handled on mutually agreeable terms for each specific case.

#### 5. Financial Arrangement

- 1) Any cooperation under this MoU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval by relevant authorities.
- 2) Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and program specific arrangements.

#### 6. Intellectual Property Rights

- 1) Each party shall protect, within its territory, intellectual property rights of the other party.
- 2) In case of specific arrangement, programs or projects that may result in intellectual property, the institutions shall conclude separate arrangement in accordance with their respective laws and regulations.

#### 7. Confidentiality

In the event that either party wishes to disclose any data and/or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of this MoU, the disclosing party shall have prior written consent from the other party.

#### 8. Settlement of Disputes

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MoU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the parties.

#### 9. Amendment

- 1) This MoU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MoU.
- Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the parties.

#### 10. Entry into Force, Duration and Termination

- 1) This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
- 2) This MoU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for another period of five (5) years by mutual written consent of the parties.
- 3) Either party may terminate this MoU at any time by giving written notification to the other party on its intention to terminate this MoU, six (6) months prior to the date of the termination.
- 4) The termination of this MoU shall not affect the completion of any projects and programs in progress and not completed at the time of termination.
