Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed between **Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidyalaya (Autonomous)**, Kaku Seth Ukka Marg, Chandra Nagar, Latur (**First Party**) and the **Scape E Recycler Pvt. Ltd.** located at Purna, Dist. Parbhani, Maharashtra 431511 (**Second Party**) on **18th May, 2022**

Whereas the Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidyalaya (Autonomous), Latur is one of the prime Educational Institution in Marathwada region of Maharashtra.

Whereas the Scape is recognized as the leading E-waste Management company in the Marathwada region of Maharashtra and registered under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs with CIN: U37100MH2021PTC365770 for its strength in creating values in the consumer's data security, safety, and environment-friendly disposal of E-waste;

PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF THE MOU:

The purpose of this MOU is to facilitate collection, transportation, handling and recycling of e-waste from **Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidyalaya (Autonomous), Latur**. The Second Party promises and agrees to furnish all customary work necessary to fully and adequately supply the professional e-waste Management, including Collection, Processing, Recycling and Disposal Services necessary for the cause assigned.

The specific terms of this contract are as follows: -

1. The second party we will be lifting *only* e-waste related items.
2. Rates will be mutually decided by both the parties.
3. The both parties may organize different activities like conferences, seminars, or awareness lectures about E-waste.
4. Both the parties will take initiative in development of collaborative research projects.
5. Exploring future possibilities for student mobility including internship/training in the industry

The material will include hereafter as all forms of e-waste and/or e-scrap collected out of discarded electronics equipments of all kinds as per the list attached herewith,

including but not limited to IT Equipments like printers, printer cartridges, faxes, copiers, spares.

It should also include, but not limited to laptops, notebooks, desktops. servers, network personal equipment, monitors, cathode ray tubes, liquid crystal displays, telephones, data assistants, mobile phones, process control equipment server towers, server racks, scanners, batteries, electronic storage media, all accessories, components and peripherals for above mentioned equipment.

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the First Party covenants and agrees that it shall as written in the MOU. The Second Party covenants and agrees all the terms and conditions of this MOU. This MOU may not be modified in any manner unless in writing and signed by both parties. This document and any attachment here to constitute the entire MOU between the parties. This MOU shall be binding upon the parties, their successors, heirs and assigns and shall be enforced under the laws.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

Confidential information means any and all information in whatever form provided by the disclosing Party and relating to the Activities, provided such information is either (a) marked as confidential at the time of disclosure; or (b) if not in a form that can be readily marked (e.g. an oral, visual or electronic form), is identified by the disclosing Party as confidential at the time of disclosure, or (c) if, given the circumstances of the disclosure, the receiving Party reasonably ought to know that it should be treated as confidential. No disclosure under this MOU or Project Agreement shall be considered an offer to sell or a public disclosure.

TERM OF MOU:

This MoU shall commence on the date of this MoU above and shall remain in effect for a period of five (05) years. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving Thirty (30) days prior notice to the other Party. This MoU can be extended by mutual written agreement of both Parties. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the implementation of the projects established under it prior to such termination.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

The Parties shall use their best endeavors to settle amicably any difference or dispute arising under or in connection with this MoU by consultation and negotiation. If a dispute cannot be settled through such consultations, upon the request of either party with written notice to the other party, any such dispute shall be resolved by arbitration in accordance with the rules of Arbitration of the Indian Council of Arbitration and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the Parties. The place of arbitration will be the city of Latur.


