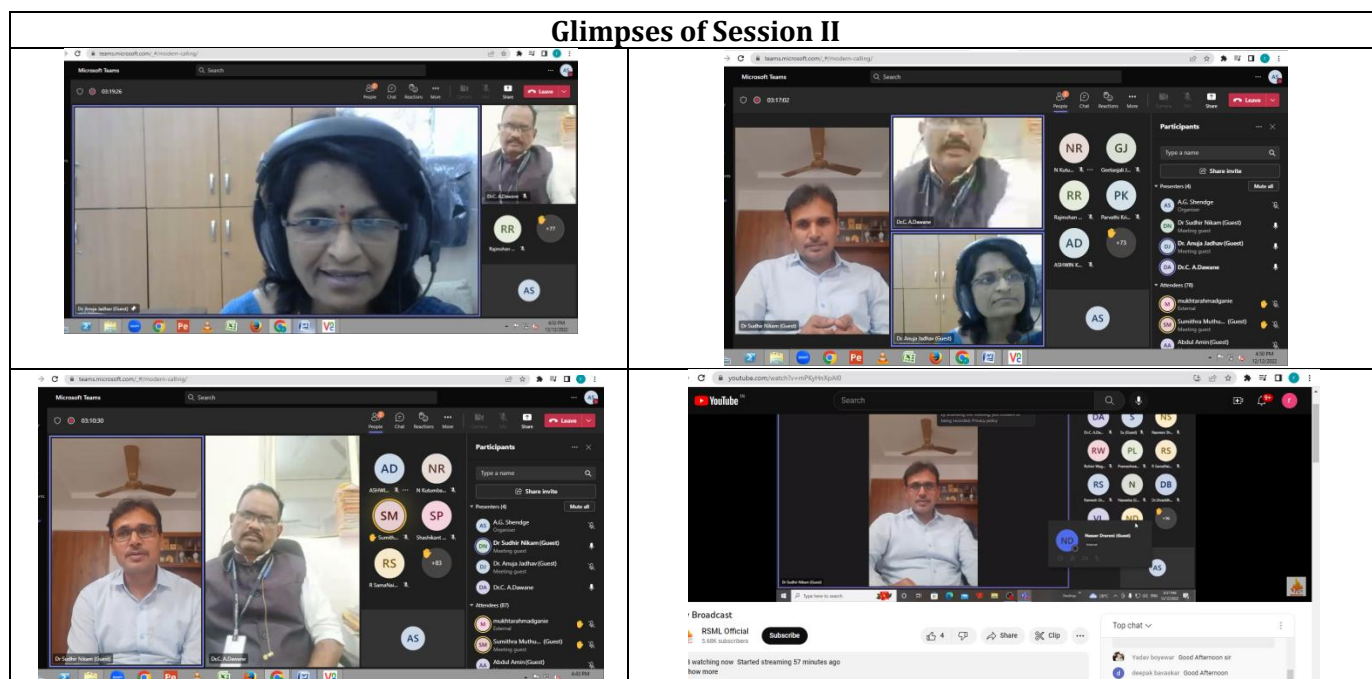
#### Brief summary:

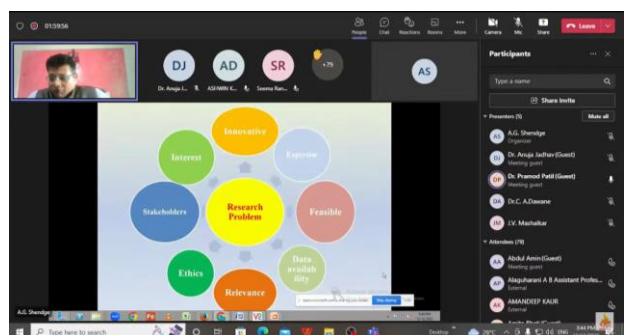
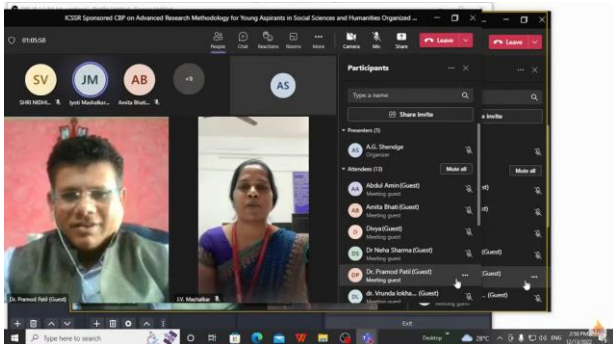
#### Brief summary:

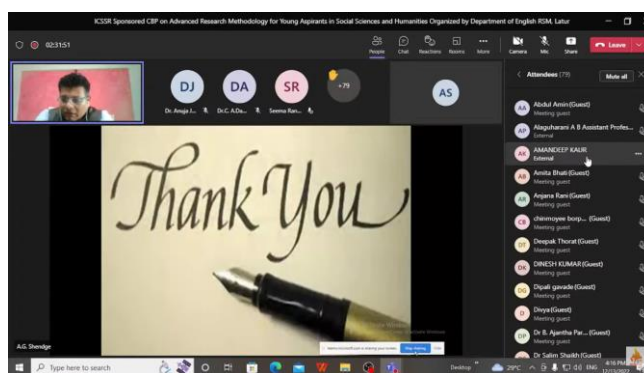
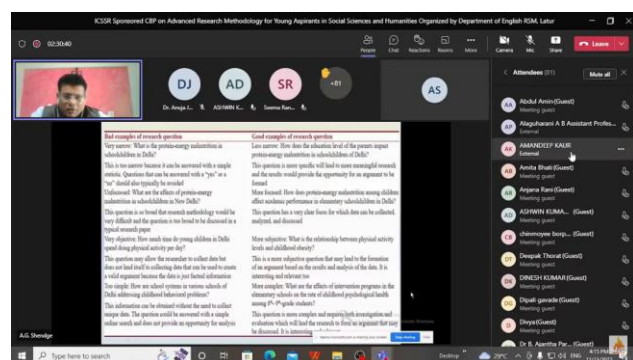
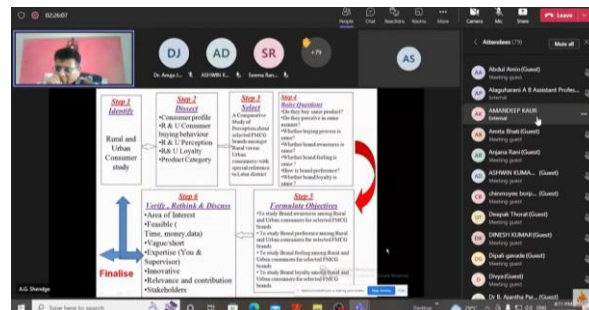
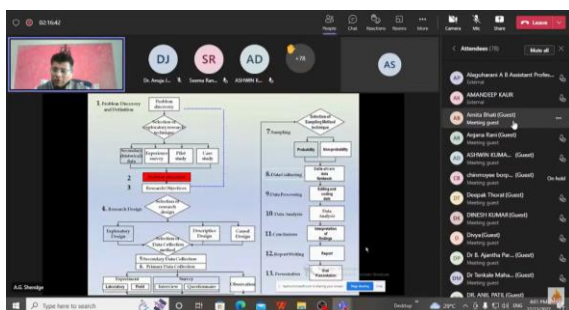
### Brief summary:

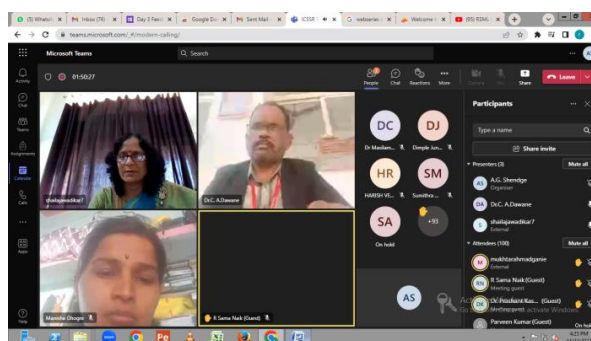
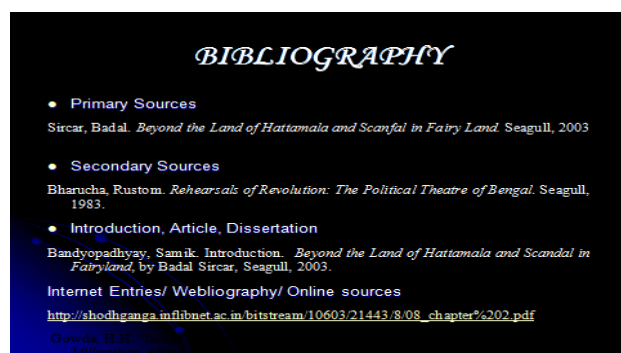
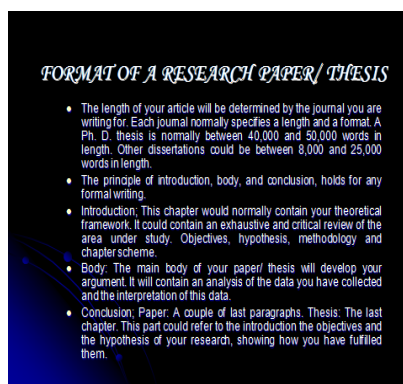
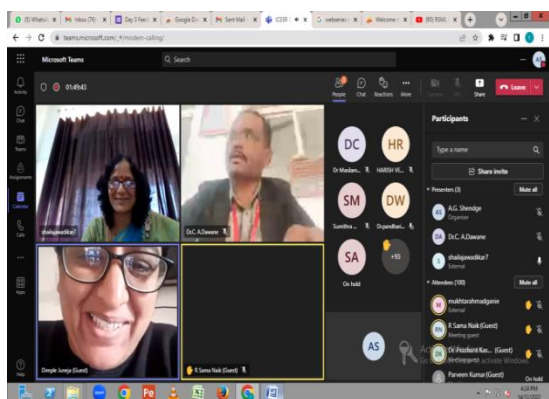
- **Writing a paper or a thesis: A Formal task**
- The three stylistic levels: formal, the informal, and the colloquial styles
- Formal: The use of rhetorical devices, an impersonal tone, long sentences, and unfamiliar words with no contractions.
- The informal style: shorter sentences, idiomatic expressions, and the diction mainly comprises the popular words used by almost everybody.
- Colloquial style is that is mostly used in the spoken form. Examples: dialogues in fiction or chatting writing. Consists of short sentences, many abbreviations and colloquialisms.
- Appropriate style: Formal style





**Brief summary:** Qualitative research is used to gain an understanding of human behavior, intentions, attitudes, experience, etc., based on the observation and interpretation of people. It is an unstructured and exploratory technique that deals with highly complex phenomena. This kind of research is usually done to understand the topic in-depth. It is carried out by taking interviews with open-ended questions, observations that are described in words, and so on.

## Glimpses of Session I

**Hypothesis Testing:**

- Parametric tests usually assume certain properties(parameters) of the parent population from which we draw samples. But non-parametric tests do not depend on any assumption about the parameters of the parent population. Non-parametric tests need more observations than parametric tests i. e. large sample size. Chi Square test was non parametric test and applied for large sample. In this unit we have to study parametric tests also i.e. T Test and F Test.

**STEPS IN APPLICATION OF X<sup>2</sup> TEST**

- First of all, calculate the expected frequencies on the basis of given hypothesis or on the basis of null hypothesis.  
Expected frequency of any cell(E<sub>ij</sub>) =  $\frac{R_i \cdot C_j}{GT}$   
(Row total for the row of that cell) x (Column total for the column of that cell) / (Grand total)  
e.g. E<sub>11</sub> = R<sub>1</sub>C<sub>1</sub>/GT E<sub>22</sub> = R<sub>2</sub>C<sub>2</sub>/GT
- Obtain the difference between observed and expected frequencies. (O<sub>ij</sub>-E<sub>ij</sub>)
- Find out the squares of such differences i.e., calculate (O<sub>ij</sub>-E<sub>ij</sub>)<sup>2</sup>.

**Calculation of Chi Square Value**

$\chi^2 = \sum \frac{(O-E)^2}{E} = 34.35$

For Degrees of freedom (v) in this case =  $(r-1)(c-1) = (3-1)(2-1) = 2$ . The table value of  $\chi^2$  for 2 degree of freedom at 5 per cent level of significance is 5.99.

The calculated value of  $\chi^2$  (34.35) is greater than the table value of  $\chi^2$  (5.99). Hence, the above null hypothesis ( $H_0$ ) is rejected. It means that there is relationship between sex and preference of color.
