It was decided after compressive discussion that the various courses and its syllabus as per CBSE norms and other

Subject 1: To give the approval for the minutes of the last meeting which was held on 25th of April 2017

The resolutions were made by the First 'Board of Study Committee' for M. A. M. C. J. during their meeting which was held on 25th of April 2017, were discuss in detail and unanimously approved.

It was even further decided and finalized that the Syllabus according to the Framework which was decided by the First 'Board of Study Committee' for M. A. M. C. J. during their meeting which was held on 25th of April 2017. However all the proceedings were approved and accepted by the Present 'Board of Study Committee' for M. A. M. C. J.

Subject No. 2: To design and finalise the syllabus for third semester and give an approval for the same.

It was decided and finalized that;In the meeting held today,

The syllabus for the Third Semester of the Second Year of degree M. A. M. C. J. to have

Two course Core and Two course choice based. As per the CBSE pattern and the norms; for the Choice based course, If the minimum number of 10 students are admitted then only the particular course be taught or the particular course to be chosen by the majority of the students. It was also decided that no faculty is burdened during such process.

The Third semester to have Radio, TV and Film Journalism was suggested/ proposed by Prof.. Dr. Sunder Rajdeep Sir for the syllabus. Which was then further discussed and approval given. The same subject and Advertisement can develop the skill in the students and hence it was included in syllabus and given approval for.

Then Prof. Dr. Balaji Shinde gave suggestion to include some more elements to the syllabus of Sports Journalism.

The syllabus for the Sports Journalism was unanimously agreed and finalized and same was approved by the honorable members of the Board of Study Committee.

Subject: To discuss and finalise the syllabus for the Fourth semester to have Internship, Study Tour, and Dissertation.

It was finalised that;

As it was expected that by reducing the number of Theory subjects for the fourth semester of the Second year and to include more professional elements like Practical's, Dissertation, Internship and Study Tour to be made mandatory in the M. A. M. C. J. degree syllabus.

The honorable members of the Board of Study Committee has unanimously agreed and recommend that;

After having checked all the possibilities, It is accepted that the internship and Study tour serves as the knowledge boosters for the students of M. A. M. C. J. degree course. There by the students will turn towards the Research activities and recommends the same.

After the conclusion the BOS Committee has reduced the One 100 marks subject and included and made Dissertation as mandatory. And instead of One practical subject the Study Tour and Internship was made mandatory.

During the Fourth Semester; News Media Technology has also made mandatory subject. Some elements were suggested by Prof. Dr. Rajendra Gonarkar and by Prof. Dr. Yashwant Bhandare. Finally syllabus of four major elements was approved by all members of BOS Committee.

The syllabus for the subjects like International Communication was prepared by Prof. Dr. Yashwant Bhandare and the syllabus for Magazine Journalism was prepared by Prof. Dr. Balaji Shinde.

The syllabus for all the above Four subjects were under discussion during the meeting of BOS and the same has also been accepted and approved.
