The agenda for the said meeting was as follows.

1. To approve the minutes of the previous meeting.
2. Approval of Syllabus for First Year Starting from the academic year 2022-23, M. C.J.
3. To start a certificate course for 12th pass student .
4. To approve and prepare a course for starting a certificate course related to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's journalism.
5. Instead of the short research (Dissertation) required for the student, finding other options and making such provision.
6. To discuss the topic that is present at the time.

Commencement of the meeting Prof. Shivshankar Patwari as the Chairman welcomed all the honorable members.

From academic year 22-23, the members of the board of studies constituted for the next three years by introducing each other. After that, in the academic year 2021-22, how the entire course was taught online while keeping a distance even when there was a situation of Covid-19. The college gave information about how the examination of first and second year students was successfully conducted online. On this occasion, information was given that educationally important activities of the students were also planned online. In the meeting some resolutions were unanimously approved after discussing giving below.

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Subject no. 1 . Approving the resolutions of the meeting held on 26th July 2021 Discussion In the meeting held on 26th July 2021 at 11.30 am Approving the introduction of a certificate course for the minimum 12th level students, approving the syllabus for the first year starting from the academic year 2022-23. Incorporation of new guidelines regarding media in the curriculum, approval of project instead of thesis for disabled students in the period of Covid-19, online practicals in PDF format and some other topics were discussed in detail. Resolution - Due to the ongoing situation of Covid-19, social distancing is necessary. In such a situation students Being sent for internship can be scary so if the situation continues in the future then it was unanimously approved to take up projects instead of internship in the future too.

Subject No.2. To approve the syllabus design for MCJ first year commencing from the academic year 2022-23.

Discussion: It was proposed in the last meeting that from the academic year 2022-23, new elements should be included by changing some courses and changing the elements of some courses for the first year MCJ. Further more, the feedback from the teachers working in other places suggested that Current Affairs course should be omitted and Advertising and Public Relations should be combined in the third semester and should be applied as core course in the second semester. It was discussed. Considering the growing dominance of social media along with newspaper writing skills in the course of news gathering and editing in the first semester, it has been suggested to include writing skills for these media in the curriculum, the last component of the curriculum is being changed to include writing for digital media. In the course of media law in the second semester, the May guidelines implemented by the central government in the context of social media from 26 May 2021 have been included in the third component. It was discussed in the last meeting to introduce a new course of 100 marks called Public Relations and Advertising instead of Current Affairs in the second semester. Because instead of studying current affairs separately, students have been suggested to include public relations and advertising as a basic course along with this course.

RESOLUTION :- In MCJ first year and second semester from the academic year 2022-23 instead of the 100 marks course of Current Affairs, a combined 100 marks course on Public Relations and Advertising will be introduced. A resolution was passed.

Subject No.3. To approve the course for a 12th pass student to start a degree or certificate course.

Discussion: As only postgraduate course is conducted under this department, it was suggested to start a certificate course for 12th pass students apart from this course, according to the last meeting, media studies should be started from the academic year 2022-23 by the name of Basic and Advance which will be for 2 credits.

Resolution:- It was unanimously approved to start certificate course as above for the students having minimum 12th pass qualification through MCJ department.

Subject No. 4 Starting a course related to Journalist Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar.

Discussion: On behalf of the Marathi Department of Rajarshi Shahu Mahavidya Autonomous, Latur, a national seminar was organized on the centenary progress of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's journal *Muknayak*. At that time, Hon. Former MP Dr Sunil Gaikwad made the above demand. As a positive response to this demand, it was discussed that such a course for one semester and at least two credits can be started. Moreover, after discussing what should be included in this course, it was approved that the said course should be started under the name of Journalist Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar.

Resolution :- It was unanimously approved to start a certificate course for two credits in the name of Journalist Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar from the academic year 2022-23.

Subject No.5. To make such provision by searching for other options instead of the required minimization program for the students.

Discussion: Research Based Dissertation is One of the compulsory subjects in MCJ course but which is very difficult for the students is research paper. This subject is considered as an integral part of postgraduate education for students as per UGC norms. But as many students do not complete it on time and seriously, it is adversely affecting the results of the department and the future life of the students. It was considered in the meeting whether you can give some options for this. Some of the subjects are linked to the curriculum criteria and students are prepared as resources after post-graduation.



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As it is linked to the criteria and students are prepared as resources after post-graduate education, it is exempted from dissertation if the students produce a documentary of at least 30 minutes that enlightens or informs on an unfamiliar topic and presents it in a technical manner, discussing whether it can be changed by you in technical form. All the members agreed on the conclusion that should be given in the meeting.

Resolution:- It was unanimously agreed that instead of MCJ 2nd year Dissertation, a documentary of at least 30 minutes on an important, unfamiliar topic should be exempted from the Dissertation.

Subject No. 6 To discuss the topic that is present at the time.

Discussion: Not a single topic was discussed in the said meeting.

The meeting was held in a friendly atmosphere. On this occasion, all the members presented their opinions on all the issues of the meeting and the various resolutions were unanimously approved.

At the end of the meeting, the chairman of the meeting, Prof. Shivshankar Patwari, thanked all the members for the various ideas presented in the meeting and for taking the time to attend the meeting.
