The Board of Studies in English meeting was conducted on 26.03.2025 at 3:00 pm in Audio-visual Hall of English department. It was also on online mode on Google meet platform. The chairperson of the meeting Dr. Anuja Jadhav, HOD welcomed all the respected BOS members in the meeting. Dr. Prashant Mothe was physically present for the meeting. Dr. Sachin Bhandare started the meeting with the help of PPT presentation. After sharing PPT, Dr. Anuja Jadhav mam read out the previous meetings minutes and the BOS meeting was started. In this meeting, Dr. Atmaram Gangane, Dr. Sudhir Nikam and Subani Babu Mam were present on Google meet platform.

Agenda 1: To take review on curriculum.

Dr. Prashant Mothe and Dr. Atmaram Gangane also suggested the same and supported to Dr. Nikam and Dr. Basu mam.
